2. You must plan to further your education at a college, university, or technical school, and you must meet the necessary entrance requirements of that institution.
3. You are encouraged to submit a letter of recommendation from a teacher, but one is not required. *Please follow instructions in application.*
4. If you are a finalist, you must be willing to be interviewed by the scholarship committee.
5. You must demonstrate and/or describe your creativity (performing arts, writing, design, class project, etc).
