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**Scholarship Amount:** \$1,000 award; must be used for payment of tuition/fees or on-campus housing at the university student attends

**Criteria:** This award will be presented to at least one senior student who best meets the following criteria:

1. You must be a senior at Pike High School **pursuing Core 40 distinction or higher.**
2. You must have been a Pike High School student for grades 9-12.
3. You must have a **GPA of 3.5 or greater.**
4. You must plan to further your education at a college, university, or technical school, and you must meet the necessary entrance requirements of that institution.
5. You must be an active participant in the community, demonstrated by your involvement in extracurricular activities, athletics, or service activities.
