Scholarship Amount: \$1,000 award; must be used for payment of tuition/fees or on-campus housing at the university student attends

Criteria: This award will be presented to one senior student who best meets the following criteria:

1. Must be a graduating senior at Pike High School with a GPA of 2.5 or higher and display commitment to school and community.
2. Must plan to complete a two-year or four-year program at an accredited college or university in the state of Indiana and must meet the necessary entrance requirements of that institution.
3. Must be planning to pursue a two-year or four-year degree in structural engineering, architecture, building trades, drafting, business, finance, accounting, or another field related to building trades.
4. Must demonstrate a strong work ethic.
5. You must include a copy of your transcript with the application.

Application Deadline: All application materials must be turned in to Ms. Bush at the PHS College & Career Resource Center no later than **3:00 p.m. on March 16, 2018.**

Late or incomplete applications will not be considered for this award.
