Background Information: The Plan to Succeed Student Scholarship is a one-time scholarship offered by a Pike High School graduate. He is a local business owner, author, and former comedian. Feel free to show *your* personality in your answers. He will appreciate it.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000 award; must be used for payment of tuition/fees or on-campus housing at the university student attends

Criteria: This award will be presented to at least one senior student who best meets the following criteria:

1. You must be a first-generation college student (the first member of your immediate family to attend college).
2. You must have a **grade point average between 2.7-3.5**
3. You must have been a Pike High School student for at least three years.
4. You must plan to further your education at a college, university, or technical school, and you must meet the entrance requirements of that institution.
5. You must be an active member of the student body as demonstrated by your participation in extracurricular activities and/or you must be employed full-time or part-time in a paying job.
