

Remembering a Pike Family

Ed Siegel, Pike's basketball coach from 1970-1995, and his wife Carmen were remembered at their Celebration of Life on June 18, 2021. On October 9th, Ed and Carmen's son Mark Siegel, '77, will be inducted into the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame along with Alan Darner, former Pike basketball coach. Mark was a Pike basketball player and went on to the University of Evansville. He and his fellow teammates were killed in the tragic crash of their team plane while taking off for an away game on December 13, 1977.

The Siegel family (Ed and Carmen; Mark, '77; Julie, '78; and David, '83) were and are loved and respected members of the Pike family and history.
